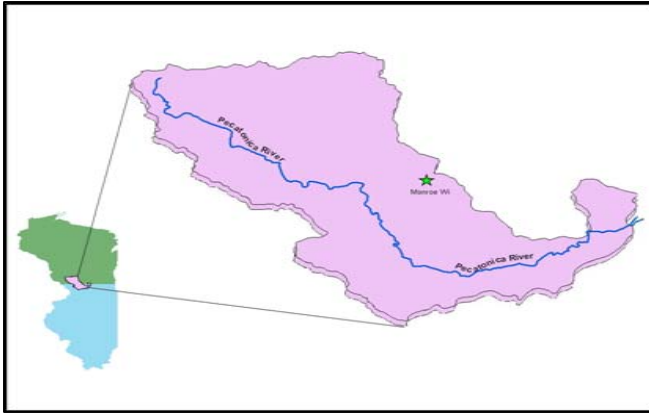

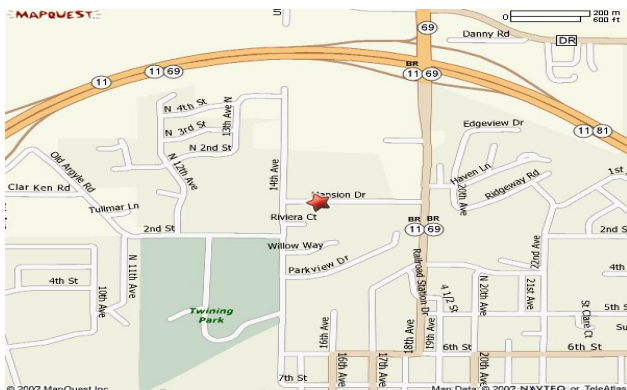
“TAKE-HOME STEWARDSHIP”
