RESOLVED;
WHEREAS;

The Town of Marengo town board supports unanimously the designation of the Brunswieler Wild River and two scenic lakes, Beaver Dam and Mineral proposal being put forth to the State of Wisconsin. This proposal was voted on at the December 11, 2006 meeting.

We feel that the unique geological, wildlife and natural beauty and value should be protected for future generations.

This area represents a rare opportunity for the state to ensure with their designation that protection of these northern rocky highlands of the Lake Superior area, along with the water resources be preserved.

The DNR has designated the Brunswieler River, included in this proposal, as an outstanding water resource complimenting our resolve.

The "Hanson forest" portion of this proposal was the #1 requisition of the Forest Service from the University of Wisconsin denoting the high value placed on this land.

We respectfully request the state of Wisconsin designate the area in question as a Wild River and Scenic Lakes Resource.
