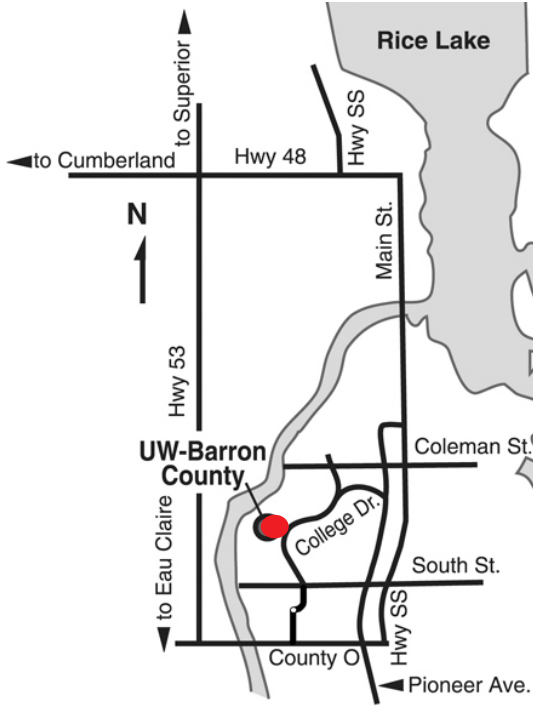


Map to UW Barron County, Rice Lake, WI



From the south on US 53

Take US 53 to CTH O, exit CTH O and turn right. Follow CTH O to Pioneer Ave. Turn left and proceed to South St. Turn left and proceed to College Drive. Turn right and proceed to UW-BC.

From the west / northeast on WI 48

Take WI 48 to US 53 and turn on US 53 south. Take U.S. 53 to CTH O, exit CTH O and turn left. Follow CTH O to Pioneer Avenue. Turn left and proceed to South St. Turn left and proceed to College Drive. Turn right and proceed to UW-BC.



The workshop will be held in the Osprey room which is located on the first floor of the Student Center.

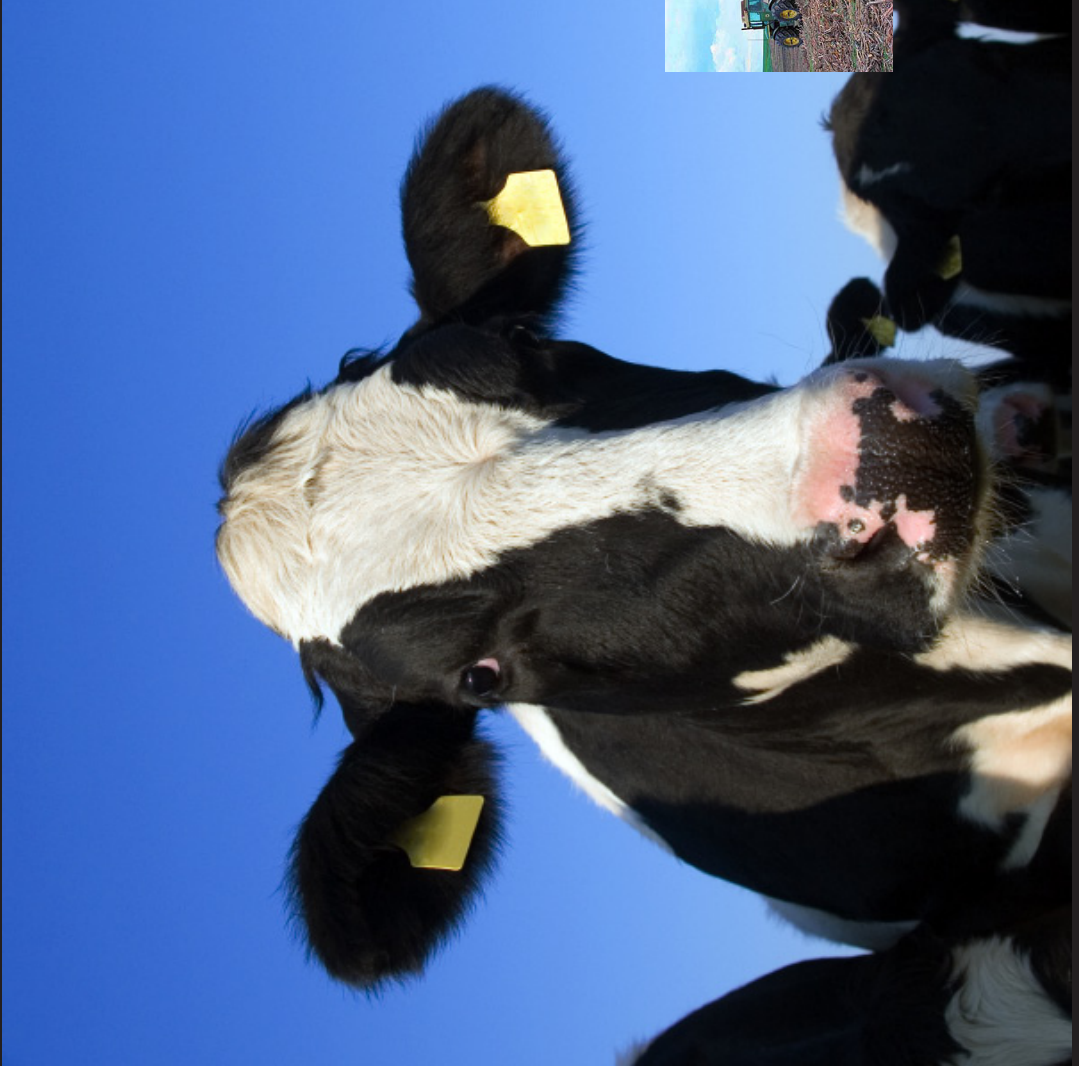
